

## Communion Clean-Up Basics in times of Pandemic

(Assumes one service) (Revised 9/22/21)

Remove all communion items from the communion tables. The wine and juice have been consecrated, so we pour any leftover wine/juice on the ground outside the Sacristy door.

Any left-over bread should be placed in a storage bag and put into the refrigerator. The Pastors will use these for communion with shut-ins during the week. Any left-over gluten-free wafers can be returned to the bag they came from.

Cups and the trays they come in can be washed in the sink. There are plastic basins and drainers under the sink for this purpose.

Clean dish towels are found in the cabinet to the left of the sink. Used dish towels can be hung on the rack to the right of the sink.

When there are four or five towels on the rack, take them home and launder them, putting them back in the cabinet to the left of the sink when done.

The hot water timer should turn itself off. Even so, check it to make sure nothing is amiss (like a stuck dial).
